### Notes from the update:

Mrs Geoghegan has asked the Friends to keep back £10,000 for a large project. A large amount via Easy Fundraising was from the Christmas period.

#### 4. School Wish List

Mrs Patterson had an update from Mrs Geoghegan:

- One of the school boilers is leaking. The estimated repair/replacement cost is £5-6K. There is a possibility that the Diocese of St Albans may pay/contribute should it have a surplus. We will know at the end of April. ACTION- Mrs Geoghegan/Patterson to update the Friends should any funding be required.
- Mrs Geoghegan has advised that the school budget is very tight and the school will become more dependent on support from the Friends.

## Academic year 2016-2017:

- As things stand currently Class 2 will have 31 pupils (18 year 1's and 13 year 2's.) This may change by September but the school will need to budget for an additional teacher for this class. In the future the Friends may be asked to contribute towards a fund to help increase staffing levels. There was general agreement that should this be necessary the Friends must not be involved in any of the decision making processes regarding staffing. Any support will be purely financial. ACTION- Mrs. Geoghegan to update if there is any support needed from the Friends.
- 15 places were allocated for Class 1, however, there is the possibility of this increasing to 17 before September.

#### 5. Committee changes -

### Discussion over roles including Year reps

Anna advised that Job specs for all committee roles and year reps have been created.

There was general agreement that year reps should be changed every year so that more people can be involved.
