2018-19 Results

We have received two letters from Rachel Macfarlane, Director of Educational Services at Herts for Learning. The first letter congratulating us on our wonderful KS2 results. Little Gaddesden was one of only 13 schools in Hertfordshire whose pupils achieved or exceeded 85% at ARE (Age Related Expectations) and 30% GD (Greater Depth). The second letter congratulating us on our outstanding Reception GLD outcomes (Good Level of Development). Little Gaddesden was one of just 35 schools across Hertfordshire whose reception cohort attained a GLD of 85% or higher.
