● ● ● Tuition

- We supply bespoke music tuition during the school day, on the school premises.
- We follow a structured approach to learning whilst tailoring each lesson to the needs of the student.
- We support any students that wish to study for music examinations, both Rock School and classical grades and tutor them accordingly.
- We help and support many students gain a place at their chosen secondary school through the music criterion.
- We encourage all students to perform, holding regular concerts throughout the year.
- We offer individual tuition for 30 minutes or 20 minutes and paired tuition for 30 minutes or 20 minutes.
- We provide a total of 33 lessons throughout the year and offer assemblies and concerts to the children and parents.
- We provide an annual report of student progress and can be contacted at any time for any queries or updates.

● ● ● Fees

- Fees are charged on a pro-rata basis at a very competitive rate. Fees are collected termly, in advance.
- We require half a terms notice for cancellation of lessons or payment of half a terms fees in lieu of such notice.
- Fees are payable on receipt of our invoice and lessons missed through pupil absence are forfeited. Any lessons missed through absence of the teacher will either be refunded or made up for at a later date.
