## Trip to Celtic Harmony, Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> October

We have planned an exciting trip to Celtic Harmony, near Hertford, on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> October. We will travel by coach, leaving at 8.45am and returning at 3.15pm. The children should arrive in school at 8.30am.

Children are encouraged to dress up in Stone Age Style. Ideas for simple Stone Age costumes are attached, but it is important to remember we will be outdoors almost all day.

Children will need a packed lunch, and Celtic Harmony have told us that our quest is to make this waste-free! They have provided the following tips:

- *Reduce; When choosing items for your picnic, avoid over-packaged goods, and individual sized items.*
- *Re-use; Put your sandwiches in a small margarine container, ice-cream container or old bread bag instead of buying food bags, foil and cling-film. Pack your own cakes, biscuits, raisins, crisps, etc. from large bulk buys into re-usable bags or containers.*
- *Rinse; Aluminium foil can be washed and re-used!*
- *Refill; A drinks bottle with squash or juice instead of throwing cartons and cans away.*

Our usual rules (no sweets, fizzy drinks or nuts) also apply. Each child must also bring a water bottle and a waterproof coat, plus any medical equipment such as inhalers or epipens.

Finally, the children have been asked to take part in a Celtic Trading Activity, and for this they will need to bring £2 pocket money in a named envelope.

The cost of the trip is £25.00

## CELTIC COSTUMES MADE EASY!
