
If your circumstances change and you believe your child is now eligible for learning in school, please contact the school office to discuss.


Class 3:

We have all been amazed at your wonderful creativity when creating you models of South America. Pupils in school have also created models, although, having left ours to air-dry they are not quite ready for painting.




Sam W- carefully trimming around a template and then the finished, labelled model






