Welcome to Reception!

We are all so proud of the children and how they settled into their first few days of Primary School. They are getting to know the routines of the classroom and the layout of the school. If you have concerns or questions please see a member of the Reception team at the beginning or end of the day.

This term we will be learning.....

### Literacy

We will have a daily phonics session where your children will learn about the letter sounds. We aim to cover 2 sounds and a high frequency word each week, these will be sent home with the children for you to reinforce.



### Reading

The children are encouraged to select a book from our class library to bring home and share with you. We will shortly introduce reading books, initially with no words. These are to encourage the children to tell the story by using the pictures as clues. Please share this book every day and write in their reading record. Thank you.

### Mathematics

We shall start by looking at recognising numbers from 0 to 10 and then beyond. The children will practice matching quantities to numbers. We will learn a variety of number rhymes and play lots of number games. We will move on to ordering numbers and looking at 2D shapes and their properties



### Topic

For the first half term, we will be learning all about ourselves in our topic Me, Myself and I! This will include looking at.....our favourite things, our friends and family, our senses and our bodies. To help us with this, please could you send in a 6x4 or 7x5 picture of your child with the family for our display.



We will also be using ipads, laptops and our computer to ensure access to ICT across all areas of the curriculum.

After half term, we will move on to thinking about Celebrations including birthdays, Diwali and Christmas.
