Dear parents and carers,

## **End of term arrangements and Covid notification**

As you have probably seen in the recent press, there has been discussion around the last day of term. Schools are also being asked to continue to monitor **any** covid cases in their community for 6 days after the end of term.

The Government has given schools the option of using one of our 5 INSET days on the 18th December, thereby allowing schools to monitor covid cases until the 23rd December rather than until Christmas Eve.

Like all schools our INSET days have already been set and you will be aware that we have chosen to have two INSET days at the start of the spring term. Our end of term will therefore remain at 1:30pm on Friday 18th December.

Should anyone in your household develop symptoms or test positive, please notify us via [covidnotice@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk](mailto:covidnotice@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk) . We will then be able to notify close contacts from school. This email will be checked daily throughout the Christmas holidays.

## **End of year assessment update**

You may be aware from the government's announcements last week that there have been changes to the end of year assessment for primary pupils. This extract is from the government update.

*It isn't just secondary school pupils who have missed time – my child is in primary school will they still have to do SATs?*

*Pupils will not have to sit the same tests they would sit in a normal year. The **key stage 1** tests in English reading and maths and the English grammar, punctuation and spelling test at*

*curious thinkers - confident individuals - independent learners - excellent results* 1

*key stage 1 and 2 will be removed for one year. We are keeping some assessments though, because it is important for us to be able to understand the progress pupils are making. Primary assessments in summer 2021 will be focused on the **phonics screening check**, teacher assessment in English reading, writing and mathematics at key stage 1, tests in **English reading and mathematics and teacher assessment in English writing at key stage 2.***

We will of course offer information meetings with details about the end of year assessments for Year 6 nearer the time.

### **Christmas services at St Peter and St Paul's Church.**

As with many other aspects of everyday life, the Church is not able to offer services as previously, however Rev'd John Russell has provided us with an update.

By arriving wearing a face mask and maintaining social distance, you can move through the Church, to the crib (which is larger this year), hear carols and listen to the Nativity Story.*

There is also a live Christmas tree, recently planted in the churchyard, near the main door, as a permanent reminder of the pandemic of 2020. This will be adorned with lights each year. We are asking people throughout the community to make weather proof decorations that can be put on it.
