Dear Parents,

Further to my letter of yesterday evening, I can now confirm more details.

### In-school provision for pupils.

For those pupils who require provision in school, please complete this [form](#) so that we can ensure sufficient provision is made for them. For pupils who will be coming into school. They should arrive by 8:50am at the front door of the school. There is no need for pupils to wear school uniform, but they should have comfortable clothing that will also allow them to take part in physical activities.

### Loan of laptops

We do have a very limited number of old laptops that we are able to loan to families to support your children's access to remote learning. As you can appreciate we need to prioritise families with no devices. You will need to complete a form covering the loan of the device and to confirm that you will ensure that online safety expectations will be followed.

If you would like to borrow a laptop, please contact the school office and we will make arrangements for you to collect it.

Work books and reading books. We are in the process of collating packs of workbooks and reading books for you children to use at home. Each class will be allocated a collection day / time and where possible we will include resources for siblings to reduce travel. Please ensure social distancing when collecting items

Tomorrow 6th January - Resource packs for Reception pupils will be available to be collected from the front of the school after 9:30am

Friday 8th January - Resource packs for Class 2 pupils will be available to be collected from the front of the school after 9:30am

Tuesday 12th January - Resource packs for Class 3 pupils will be available to be collected from the front of the school after 9:30am



Thursday 14th January - Resource packs for Class 4 pupils will be available to be collected from the front of the school after 9:30am

Collection and drop off details for following weeks will be advised.

### Access to remote learning

As a school we will be mostly using Google apps for Education to deliver remote learning. For some pupils this will be new and you will need to log in using the guidance below. If you have issues with access, please email the school office and we will be able to offer some help. It is best if any other Google Accounts are logged out first.

**Class 1** - Learning will mostly be directed via Tapestry with further details from Google Classroom. To access this you will need to sign in to your child's Google account. Pupil usernames are derived from their name together with a number. For reception pupils it would be something like: [20JohnG@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk](mailto:20JohnG@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk)

The password is *Gaddesden* - you will be prompted to reset this as soon as you sign in.

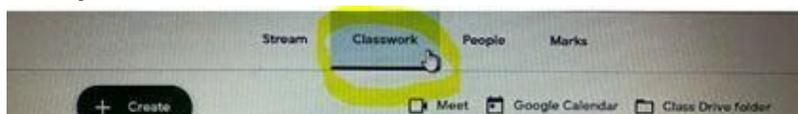

To access this you will need to sign in to your child's Google account.

Pupil usernames are derived from their full name together with a number. E.g. John Green username would be something like: [15JohnG@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk](mailto:15JohnG@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk)

For year 1 pupils it would be [19JohnG@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk](mailto:19JohnG@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk)

For year 2 pupils it would be [18JohnG@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk](mailto:18JohnG@littlegaddesden.herts.sch.uk)

The password for both year 1 and Year 2 is *Gaddesden* - you will be prompted to reset this as soon as you sign in.

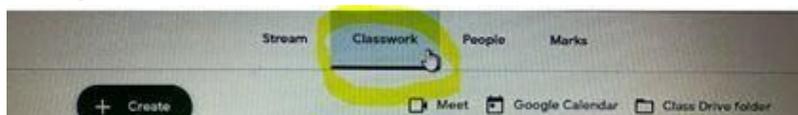
