Dear Parents and Carers,

The safety checks have now been completed and we would like to welcome you to the official opening of our new playground on Friday 24th March at 8:45am. This will give us the opportunity to formally thank the Friends and all those who helped raise a significant amount of money to make this possible.

I know it is very, very exciting and enticing for younger siblings, however please be aware that it is not designed for pre-school children. We would not like to see any child inadvertently injured on it, therefore I would ask you to keep them away from it when waiting in the playground. They will have plenty of time to enjoy themselves on the new playground when they start school.

I am delighted to share that our recent visit from our Herts School Advisor was very positive. She thoroughly reviewed our approach to phonics and early reading, hearing many children read. She observed how reading comprehension is taught across the school and gave very positive feedback to all staff. Such visits form part of our ongoing review processes, striving to ensure learning is of a consistently high standard.

I am very sad to inform you that Mr Millins will be leaving us at the end of this term. We are very grateful for all his hard work, in class, with PE and particularly with running such a wide

range of clubs. We will miss him and wish him all the very best for his next adventure and change of career.

We always love celebrating our pupils' birthdays and appreciate that often sweets are sent in to share with their friends (and sometimes staff). Could I please remind you that we are a nut free school and that any homemade cakes/food need ingredient lists in case of allergies.

Class 1 - Thank you to all who were able to attend our Hands On session. We hope you found it informative and appreciate how independent your children are with their learning.
