Dear Parents and Carers,

A quick reminder about coats and school uniform.

Class 1 - have enjoyed their new Literacy book 'The Little Red Hen' and can now retell the story by themselves using lots of actions! We have also enjoyed learning about the Hindu festival of Diwali, acting out the story of Rama and Sita, making our own divas, rangoli patterns and listening to Ameya from Class 2 and Mrs Patel explain to us how they celebrate at home.











Class 2 - We are enjoying our new History topic 'The Great Fire of London'. This week we compared fire fighting in 1666 to today. We learned that there was no fire service in 1666 and







that the people had only very basic equipment. To help us understand how hard it would have been to get water from the River Thames to the burning buildings, we acted out passing buckets along a line.

Class 3 - ¿Cuándo es tu cumpleaños? - We have practised saying when our birthdays are *en* español this week!

We also acted out the various stages of the Dowding System to better understand why radar was such an effective tool to help Britain win the Battle of Britain.
