
Dear Parents and Carers.

In Science, the children were challenged to connect a working circuit. They were then able to use their learning to predict whether a variety of different circuit diagrams would also produce a lit bulb.







Class 4 - In English we have been developing our descriptive writing through our learning about 'The Cloud Tea Monkeys'. In maths we have been securing our formal methods for multiplication and also took part in the Primary Maths Challenge.
