
Reading


For advent, Storytime magazine has a free story advent with a digital story for every day of December. They can be found <u>here</u>.

We all know the importance of children reading, whether this is early readers or those who are more confident. Research shown below, reflects the impact of reading for just 20 minutes each day.

For our younger readers, research and guidance is very prescriptive regarding the "reading" book a child takes home. This book must be an opportunity to rehearse their current phonic knowledge. It should not include words that go beyond the phonic knowledge that they have been taught so far.

Of course, all our children are encouraged to take home books to read for pleasure. For younger children especially, these are likely to be books that they will want to share with an adult who will be able to support them with less familiar words.





Class 1 - have looked at the rhyming book 'Shark in the Park' and made their very own telescopes like the main character Timothy!
