#### **Mobile Phones and Smart Watches**

As you will be aware from the media, pupils should not be using mobile phones in schools. We would not expect any primary pupils to bring a mobile phone into school, however should they

do so inadvertently it should be turned off and handed into the school office. It can then be collected from the school office at the end of the day.

Please remember that the children should not be wearing SMART watches in school. A Smart watch is one that is able to send/receive calls or messages or take photographs and therefore is treated the same as mobile phones.

<u>Class 1</u> - This week our focus has been trains, exploring trains from the past and now. We have also explored the story 'The Proudest Blue' and discussed a moment when we felt proud.



<u>Class 2</u> - The children have had an action packed week starting with our pirate afternoon to kick off our history topic. The children thoroughly enjoyed themselves and completed a range of fun activities. Including 'walking the plank'!

We have started a new book in English 'The Green Ship' by Quentin Blake. The children have made predictions and have used the book to practise reading with fluency.
