<u>Class 1:</u> have been looking closely at the story of Handa's Surprise, finding out about where our food comes from and making our own African fruit smoothies!








<u>Class 2</u>: This week, we have started our non-fiction English topic on sharks. We have looked at the features of non-fiction books and have started to write questions that we would like to research for the class fact file we are going to create.

<u>Class 3:</u> have started our learning on plants by observing some flowering plants and recording what we know about the functions of different parts.

School hours

If you have not yet completed this please do so by Friday 26th April:

From September 2024, the government announced a new minimum expectation on the length of the school week of 32.5 hours. In order to meet this requirement, we need to adjust the length of our school day.

Our proposal:

To extend our end of day from 3:15pm to 3:20pm.

For all pupils to be registered by 8.50am.

As part of this we will be changing the way in which pupils come into school - moving to a 'soft start'.

School gates will open from 8:40am and pupils will be able to come into school from 8:45 in the morning. This will also alleviate the log-jam we currently experience as pupils enter the school after lining up.

What does this mean for you?

- Access to the playground from 8:40am
- Children able to enter school from 8:45am
- Pupils to be in school and registered present by 8:50am
- School day ends at 3:20pm.

We would very much value your views regarding this.
